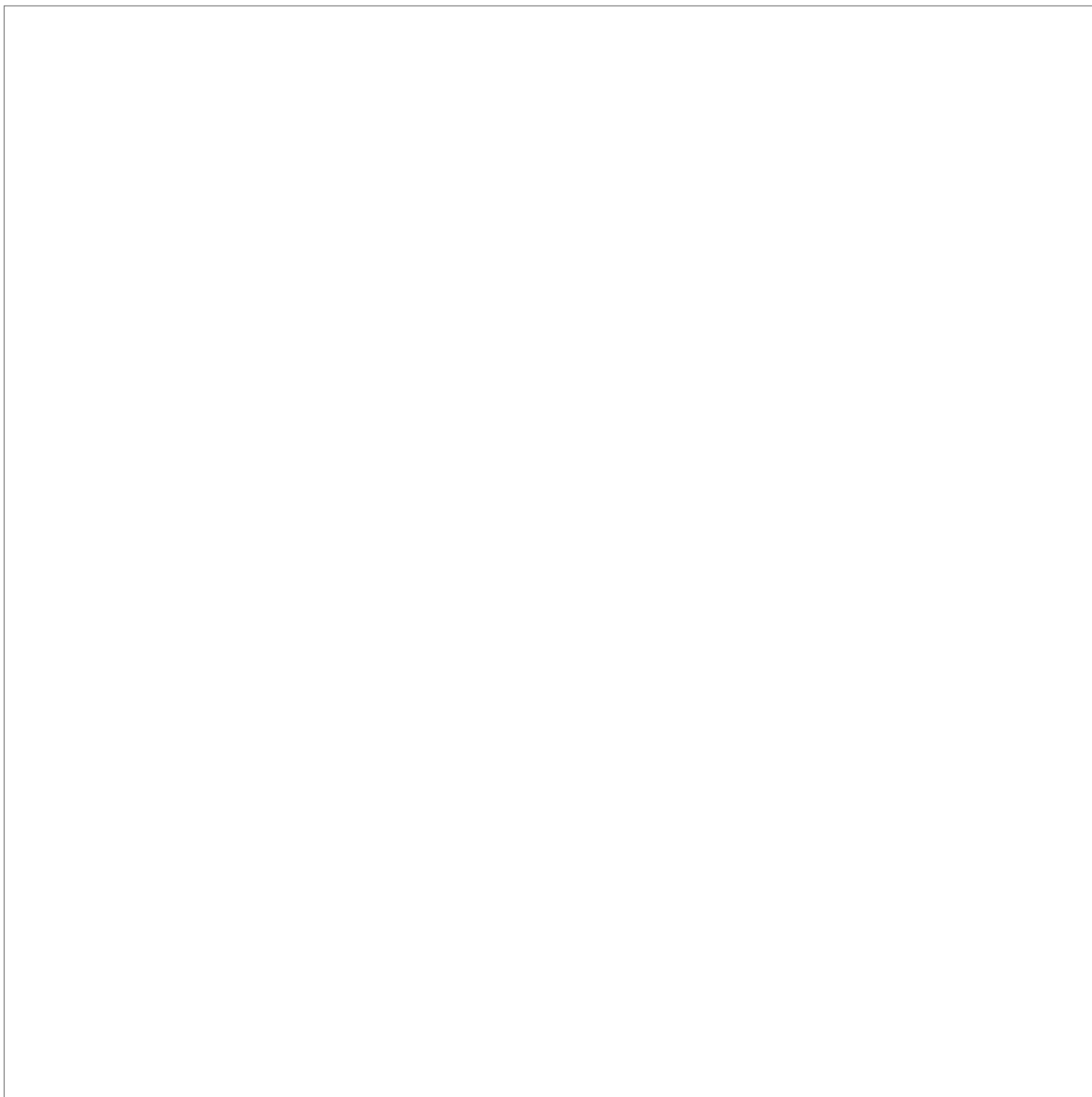


An embroidered jerkin – a prop from the School of Fine Arts
